**Scope of the proposed deliverable.**

The document would specify general requirements for third-party marks of conformity, including their issue and use. The marks covered are those issued by conformity assessment bodies and accreditation bodies.

**Purpose and justification of the proposal\***

In April 2018, the CASCO Chairman Policy and Coordination group (CPC) set a task group with the mandate of reviewing ISO/IEC 17030 *Conformity assessment -- General requirements for third-party marks of conformity*, ISO/IEC Guide 23:1982 *Methods of indicating conformity with standards for third-party certification systems* and ISO Guide 27:1983 *Guidelines for corrective action to be taken by a certification body in the event of misuse of its mark of conformity* to determine if they were still relevant and adapted to the current needs. ISO/IEC 17030 was published in 2003 and the guides in 1982 and 1983, and with no revisions since, the CPC considered it was necessary to assess whether they were still responding to the market needs.

The task group from the CPC met in September 2018 and reviewed in detail the documents and made the recommendation that ISO/IEC 17030 be revised to update it to current and future needs and to incorporate some relevant parts of ISO Guide 27 and ISO/IEC Guide 23 after which they would be withdrawn.

The CPC in November 2018 agreed to the recommendation and asked the secretariat to initiate the NWIP ballot
